

Its discreet footprint and refined finishes make it the ideal solution for listeners who want accuracy and power without overwhelming their living space.

#### **Bipolar Driver Array**

Dual 6.5" woven carbon fibre drivers are mounted in opposing alignment to eliminate cabinet vibrations and reduce distortion. This true bipolar configuration delivers fast, articulate low frequencies with surprising extension and control. The result is a subwoofer that translates amplifier power directly into pure acoustic energy, ensuring bass performance that is as musical as it is impactful.

#### **Precision Class D Power**

The BP7 features a 350-watt Universal Class D amplifier engineered for speed, control, and efficiency. Designed to handle dynamic peaks effortlessly, it delivers bass that is both powerful and nuanced. From subtle textures in acoustic recordings to the explosive dynamics of modern cinema, the BP7 maintains fidelity and control across all listening scenarios.

With superior accuracy and flexibility in placement, the BP7 appeals to listeners who value precision and realism in their audio systems.

## **Compact, Elegant Form**

Measuring just 10.6" wide and deep, and 11.4" high, the BP7 proves that powerful bass does not require a large enclosure. Satin Black and Satin White finishes, accented with polished aluminium trim rings, ensure the BP7 complements PSB's premium Imagine and PWM loudspeaker lines while fitting discreetly into any room.

# **Proprietary Driver Engineering**

Drawing from PSB's five decades of acoustic innovation, the BP7's custom drivers feature filleted rubber surrounds, oversized magnets, and 1.5" voice coils. These components allow for extended excursion and remarkable accuracy, producing bass that is not only deep and powerful but also highly musical.
